# **Palestine Strawberry Clover**

## Trifolium fragiferum

Palestine strawberry clover is a highly adaptable hard seeded perennial clover that performs well in hostile conditions. It is generally considered the best clover for toxic soils with high tolerance to salinity, alkalinity and waterlogging. It is also tolerant of the majority of insect and disease pests that affect other clovers. Palestine strawberry clover is prostrate in growth habit and slow to establish with poor winter growth, but generally is more persistent than other perennial clovers under grazing.

- Deep rooted perennial clover
- Good hard seed levels
- Good performance under hostile conditions (salinity, alkalinity & waterlogging)
